THE PLEDGE (Deuteronomy 24:6,10-12)

When you make a loan to your neighbour, do not go into their house to get what is offered as a pledge. Stay outside and let the neighbor bring the pledge out to you.

If your neighbor is poor, do not go to sleep with his cloak as a pledge in your possession. Return the cloak by sunset, so he may sleep in it. Then he will thank you and it will be regarded as a righteous act in the sight of God.
