


#### **Spectrum of failure:** <u>Deviance</u>: deliberately violating a prescribed practice. 1. Carelessness: accidentally deviating from the specifications. 2. Lack of ability: being unskilled or untrained for a task. 3. <u>Process inadequacy</u>: competent person follows flawed process. 4. Task challenge: a job is too difficult to work every time. 5. Complexity: a process of many elements fails when some interact in new ways. 6. 7. Uncertainty about future events makes sensible actions produce undesired results. 8. Hypothesis testing: an experiment to prove an idea or design fails. Exploratory testing: an experiment designed to expand knowledge leads to an 9. undesired result.
